2010 GRANTEES

Falmouth Service Center, \$3,750

To support development of a strategic plan to ensure that the work of the Falmouth Service Center continues to be responsive of need and grounded in a solid foundation.

Neighborhood Falmouth, Inc., \$1,000

To provide start-up assistance while the organization builds membership towards becoming self-sustaining.

Falmouth Historical Society, \$2,160

To produce 60 time lines on laminated styrene and sets of related images for elementary classrooms in Falmouth Public School. The visual tools will support ten new social studies units aligned with the state frameworks, enriched by Falmouth history and available on the Society web site.

Samaritans on Cape Cod & the Islands, \$1,000

To establish a support group, facilitated by survivors of suicide, for others who have been intimately affected by suicide.

Cape Cod Child Development Program, \$2,100

To support the Intergenerational Music and Movement Program, which includes music, movement and literacy activities on a weekly basis. It will serve 60 Head Start children, their families, and up to 10 senior members of the Falmouth community.

Sight Loss Services Inc, \$1,000

To defray the costs of providing our Self Help Support Group services to visually impaired Falmouth residents.

The 300 Committee, Inc., \$1,000

To purchase a wheelchair accessible picnic table to be installed at the Daniel and Carmela Bartolomei Conservation Area on Sandwich Road in East Falmouth.

Massachusetts Audubon Society: Long Pasture Wildlife Sanctuary, \$1,000

To create an interpretive package for the Ashumet Wildlife Sanctuary in Falmouth, so community members/visitors will better understand and enjoy the sanctuary and other local natural areas.

Falmouth Public Library Foundation, \$2,000

To purchase an Optelec Generation 2 Clear View and desktop magnifier machine for the Library's vision impaired patrons.
