Fall 2007 General Grant Awards

AIDS Support Group of Cape Cod

\$1,000 to support the Food and Nutrition program, which provides congregate meals, home delivered meals, monthly food baskets and emergency food baskets to men, women and children living with HIV/AIDS on Cape Cod.

Associated Advocacy Center - Visions for the Future, Inc.

\$1,000 to support special education, minority, and low income youth, who are 2-3 times more likely to be referred to juvenile court than their peers and to provide records assessment, advocacy in court and school, and rights training for parents and students.

Association to Preserve Cape Cod

\$1,000 to support the coordination of a workshop for freshwater pond stewards.

Audible Local Ledger, Inc.

\$1,000 to support the acquisition and installation of the necessary technology to enable ALL to expand services to two additional radio stations to increase their coverage and ability to reach more listeners.

Cape Care Coalition

\$10,000 to support the development of a single payer health care plan for all residents of Barnstable County.

Cape Cod Community College Educational Foundation, Inc.

\$1,000 to support the acquisition of a Cardiac Monitor for the Nursing Learning Center to allow implementation of a practice session orienting second-year students in regard to basic procedures during a cardiac arrest or "code" situation.

Coalition for Buzzards Bay

\$1,500 to support the completion of the Geographic Oil Spill Response Plan for Quisset Harbor and Sippewisset Harbor.

Community Action Committee of Cape Cod & Islands, Inc.

\$500 to support literacy and skills development for children and families residing at Safe Harbor, a shelter dedicated to working with victims of domestic violence.

Fine Arts Work Center

\$500 to support the second year of KAPE, a program designed to enhance the education of lower Cape public school students by providing after-school workshops in visual arts and writing.

Habitat for Humanity of Cape Cod

\$1,000 to support the second Youth UNITED Build, which brings young people (ages 5-25) together to raise funds and build an affordable home for a family on Cape Cod. This build will be for a house in Brewster.

Helping Our Women, Inc.

\$1,000 to support the Client Services Program, including weekly support groups, transportation to medical appointments, and financial assistance to women who are coping with chronic or life threatening illnesses.

Interfaith Council for the Homeless

\$1,500 to provide winter boots to client children as a part of the Adopt a Family program.

Rehabilitation Hospital of the Cape & Islands

\$1,000 to support the Augmentative and Alternative Communication Program to help improve the communication abilities of pediatric patients who may not be able to communicate due to disease or disability.

Town of Barnstable Human Services Committee

\$787 to pay for shelter/housing for the area's chronically homeless, whom are being identified and brought to safe places for shelter and services by the individuals involved with Operation in from the Streets.

WE CAN Corporation

\$1,000 to support Pathmakers, a program that provides mentoring and monthly training and support meetings for low income, divorced, or unemployed women from Cape Cod who have returned to school.
