Amazing Grace of Cape Cod, \$20,000

For staff expansion to renew relationships and rebuild networks for sustainability

Amplify POC Cape Cod, \$25,000

For staff expansion to build out sustainability initiatives and program infrastructure

Belonging to Each Other, \$25,000 For technology enhancements to improve client support and volunteer engagement processes

Cape Cod Chamber Orchestra, \$15,000

For staff expansion and software to streamline development, patron, and donor management processes

Community Connections, \$25,000

To pilot a thrift store to generate general operating fund revenue and provide workforce development opportunities

Health Imperatives, \$25,000

For staff expansion to strengthen internal and external immigrant support services

Health Ministry, \$25,000

For staff expansion to strengthen volunteer services and allow more opportunity to focus on strategic development

Helping Our Women, \$25,000 To establish a center for women's wellness and peer support on the Outer Cape

To establish a Communications Laboratory to increase community access and utilization of library and community programs
