



2026 Open Door Grants

In 2026, we awarded \$90,510 in grants to 10 organizations from our Open Door Grant Program, designed to give small-to mid-size nonprofit organizations access to funding through The Cape Cod Foundation. The program also gives our team the opportunity to learn more about new organizations. Grants ranged from \$4,000-\$10,000 and provided program or general operating support.

Cape Cod Senior Resource Center, \$4,000

For technology support for their Senior Impact Fund project that connects seniors in urgent need with immediate, community-driven financial support

Friends of Children's Cove, \$10,000

For general operating support and operational start-up costs to hire its first Executive Director

Friends of the Cape Cod National Seashore, \$10,000

For general operating support to strengthen fundraising infrastructure and capacity

Michael's English House, \$10,000

To support their 12-week carpentry workshops, provided at no cost to those in Addiction Recovery and coming out of the Barnstable County House of Corrections

Next Chance, Inc., \$10,000

To support their Executive Leadership and general operating capacity for women's recovery housing services

Olga's List, \$10,000

To support training and placement of direct care workers with Latham Centers, Cape Cod

Outer Cape Health Services, \$10,000

For advancing telehealth access on rural Cape Cod

Provincetown Conservation Trust, \$6,510

To expand their free nature programming and trail maintenance
